FIG. II STAMPS INTO CTR

Notes Stamps in meas 1-2 ere done in a deliberate manner. Before each stamp bend the knee and raise the ft. Stamp on the full ft with toes pointed twd ctr.

- 1 1 Stamp fwd or. R -slightly diag R
 - 2 Hold
 - 3 Stamp fwd on L slightly diag L
 - 4 Hold.
- 2 1 Stamp R fwd slightly diag R
 - 2 Stamp L fwd slightly diag L
 - 3 Stamp R fwd slightly diag R
 - 4 Hold.
- 3 1 Moving away from ctr, step L bkwd
 - 2 Hold
 - 3 Step R bkwd
 - 4 Hold
- 4 Move bkwd with 3 smaller steps (or light stamps) beg L to reform original size of circle (cts 1,2,3; hold (ct 4).

Dance is repeated eight times.
