(for meas. 1,2,4) hop on R ft, touching L toe across and in front of the R ft; hop again on the R ft, touching the L toe to the L side. Reverse ftwk for measure three.

In both styles dancers progress in LOD in meas. 1-2, and do the ftwk of meas. 3-4 in place.
